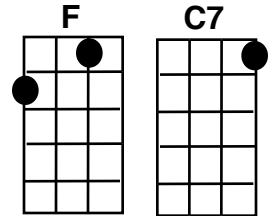


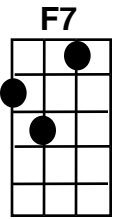

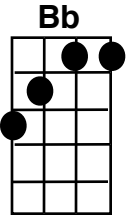

 Another season, another reason, for makin' whoopee.



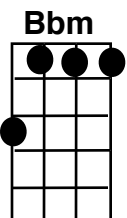
F C7 F F7 Bb Bbm

 Picture that same sweet love nest, see what a year will bring:

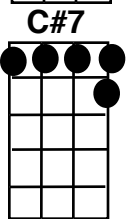

 Oh, don't forget folks, that's what you get folks, when makin' whoopee.

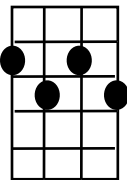

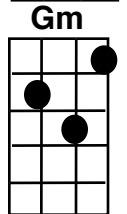

 She feels neglected and he's suspected of makin' whoopee.



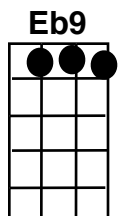
F C7 F F7 Bb Bbm
