C / Dm7 / Bb! F! / C / G

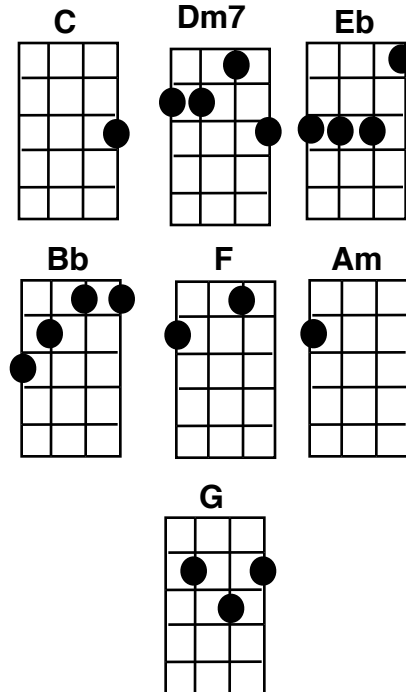
G **C**

Gotta' know what to say!

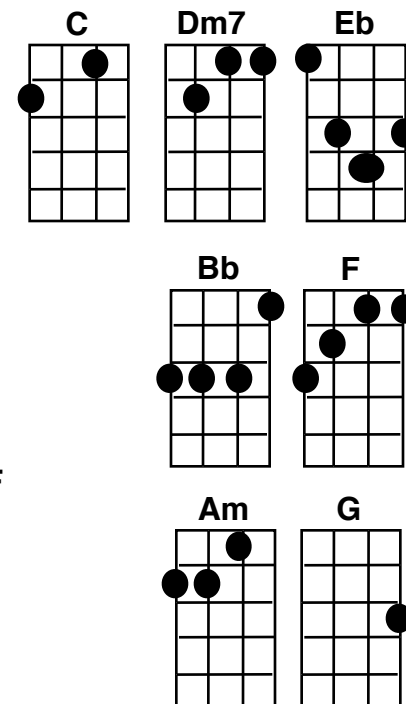
G **C**
